Dear Sirs:

The Attorney General is informed that the United States Forest Service requests an opinion from the Attorney General on the following proposition:

"The United States Forest Service, in connection with a pending land transaction between that federal agency and the Board of Regents, has asked for an opinion from your office confirming that the 'Board of Regents of the Universities and State College of Arizona is the legal successor in interest to the board of Regents of the University and State Colleges of Arizona'."

Laws 1959, Chapter 92, 24th Arizona Legislature, First Regular Session, provides:

"The name of the 'Board of Regents of the University and State College of Arizona', as the same appears in any section of the Arizona Revised Statutes or Session Laws of Arizona, is hereby changed to the 'Board of Regents of the Universities and State College of Arizona'."

The foregoing chapter contained an emergency clause and became effective March 20, 1959. It now appears as A.R.S. § 15-729, 1959 Cumulative Pocket Part to the Arizona Revised Statutes.

It is, therefore, the opinion of the Attorney General that by the enactment of Chapter 92, above referred to, that the "Board of Regents of the Universities and State College of Arizona" is the legal successor in
