The Attorney General has received from the publisher of the Arizona Weekly Gazette, an affidavit indicating the newspaper's general circulation in the State of Arizona. The Affidavit reveals that almost 2,000 persons in 50 cities and towns in each of the state's 14 counties receive this newspaper via U.S. mail.

We, therefore, conclude that the Arizona Weekly Gazette is a newspaper of general circulation in the state, so that it may be validly designated by the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission as the official newspaper for publication of legal notices.
