With reference to your query concerning whether or not lady race riders are permitted to ride in the state of Arizona, it is the opinion of the Attorney General's office that pursuant to Sec. 22 of the Rules and Regulations pertaining to definitions, read in conjunction with Rule 189 of the Rules and Regulations of Horse Racing, they may not be permitted to ride in a race where pari-mutual betting is permitted.
