Dear Governor Fannin:

The Attorney General acknowledges receipt of your letter of September 1, 1959 requesting an opinion as to whether or not members of the Arizona Development Board may legally claim reimbursement for out of state travel.

Your letter states that Mr. M. E. Hafley, of Kingman, a member of the Arizona Development Board, has presented to you for your approval a travel order to authorize Mr. Hafley to travel, as a member of the Arizona Development Board, from Kingman to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of attending the 14th Annual Convention of Association of State Planning and Development Agencies. There is attached to your letter the travel order submitted to you by Mr. Hafley, which is returned to you with this opinion.

It is the opinion of the Attorney General that A.R.S. §§ 38-621 to 38-627, inclusive, which relate to travel expenses of public officials, authorizes the expenditure by Mr. Hafley as indicated by your letter and travel order attached thereto; and that you are authorized to honor the travel order presented by Mr. Hafley.
