I am returning the communication of April 25th sent to the Governor's Office from the Great American Indemnity Company of New York, seeking information concerning the bond of Dr. George C. Truman.

I think the Company should be entitled to the information as to whether its bond has been replaced by another, together with the date upon which the new bond was filed. This I think is the extent to which the Company is entitled to information.

There is no occasion for a statement from the Governor's Office releasing the Company of liability.
