Dear Mr. Thomas:

This is acknowledging receipt of your request for an opinion on the legality of punch boards.

You are advised that the operation or use of a punch board for money or anything of value is in violation of Section 4676, Revised Code of Arizona.

Criminal action should be instituted against any one who maintains or carries on any such lottery. I think if the offenders are warned, the practice could be stopped in a short time. If not, of course, it would then be necessary to prosecute.

I would be pleased to hear from you, not later than May 1st, advising me of the condition as it exists in your county at that time.
