Dear Mr. Riggins:

In answer to your letter of October 26, 1933, wherein you inquire if Paragraph 2 of Section 3, Chapter 35, Session Laws 1933, in any way affects the duties of the State Board of Education relating to the Arizona Children's Colony (Section 1117, R. C. A. 1928, as amended by Chapter 90, Session Laws, Regular Session, 1929), I advise that Section 1117, as amended, relates only to ~~mentally defective~~ children, whereas Chapter 35, Session Laws, 1933, relates to delinquent children and does not in any way affect the duties of the State Board of Education as relating to the functions of the Board as the governing body of the Arizona Children's Colony.
