In answer to your inquiry as to whether a husband and wife can vote on a bond election in your city for a municipal water system, when only one of the two spouses actually pays the taxes on the community property, I advise that it is the opinion of the Attorney General that both spouses may vote in such an election, regardless of which one actually pays the taxes.

I am sorry that this opinion has been delayed but due to the press of work in the office it was unavoidable.
