In my letter of May 5, 1934 to you, I stated that the claim of Mr. F. M. Gold, for veteran's exemption, was a proper claim. This opinion was based upon the statement in your letter of April 7, 1934 that Battery A, 158th F. A., National Guard, was Federalized in February, 1930.

Adjutant General Temple has since advised me that the National Guard, Battery A, 158th F. A., has never been Federalized. Therefore, members of this unit have never served in the service of the U. S. Army and are not entitled to veteran's exemption.
