In answer to your letter of May 6th, 1937, requesting an opinion from this office as to whether the brand could be recorded in your office by virtue of the certified copy of the court decree vesting the estate of Y. W. Buchanan, deceased, in his surviving widow:

It is the opinion of this office that inasmuch as the brand is not specifically enumerated in the decree and there is no blank transfer, of all remaining property not mentioned, to the widow, this decree is not a sufficient transfer upon which your office may record the brand in the name of the surviving widow.
