I am sorry that in my letter of the 9th inst., regarding the issuance of a license to Dr. L. E. Polhemus of Miami, I did not completely answer your question as to whether you had the right to back date said license, to the meeting of the board held last November 15, 1936, and amend the minutes to show same was issued at that time.

As I previously stated, this case deserves all due consideration by your board. It is a case which deserves all due justice.

It is my opinion that under the provisions of Section 2, Chapter 105, Laws of 1935, wherein your honorable board is charged with the duty of carrying into effect the provisions of the naturopathic act and pass rules and regulations for its administration, that you have the power to back date said license and correct any inadvertence of the former secretary.
