Dear Sir:

I have your letter of recent date requesting an opinion as to the legality of the present certification requirement concerning principals or superintendents of school districts having an average daily attendance of three hundred or more pupils.

I am of the opinion that under the provisions of Section 989, Subsection 7, Revised Code of Arizona, 1938, that the State Board of Education may make reasonable rules and regulations concerning this subject, and that the power of the Board under said Subsection 7 includes the right to make rules and regulations regarding the certification of superintendents and principals.
