Dear Sir:

We are returning to you herewith check No. 4227 in the sum of \$1897.43, drawn by the treasurer of Apache County in favor of the Arizona State Treasurer, together with the statement which accompanied said check.

It is our opinion that under the provisions of Section 2617 R. C. A. 1928 that the treasurer of Apache County should set forth specifically what the check represents. The portion of the section of the code referred to reads as follows:

"The gross amount of all other state moneys received by any agency of the state or its political subdivisions, or any officer or person, from whatsoever source, shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit of the general fund, on or before the first day of each month after receipt of same, without any deductions whatsoever, and accompanied by an itemized statement of same, \* \* \*."

We therefore suggest that you point out the above provision to Mr. Hunter and request that he segregate and break down the item referred to in his statement as levied for 1934 and prior.
