Gentlemen:

We have your letter of August 26th relative to the dental bill passed at the last session of the legislature and desiring an interpretation of same insofar as it might prohibit advertising.

A referendum petition has been filed with the Secretary of State involving this particular law and the same cannot go into effect until it has been voted upon by the people in the next general election. It is impossible therefore for us to give an opinion on the same until such time as it becomes a law. However it has no effect at the present time and need not be taken into consideration by any person desiring to do the things prohibited by its terms.
