Dear Sir;

We have your letter of July 24, 1940 in which you state:

"How should I certify to the several Boards of Supervisors of the State, House Concurrent Resolution No. 3, proposing an amendment to the State Constitution regarding State lands; House Concurrent Resolution No. 13, proposing an amendment to the Constitution regarding public service corporations and that portion of Ch. 54, H. B. No. 103, passed by the 14th Legislature, regular session, 1939, relating to Dentistry, against which a referendum has been filed in this office?"

As to House Concurrent Resolution No. 3, you should certify to the proper election officers the following title:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Arizona relating to State lands."

As to House Concurrent Resolution No. 13, you should certify to the proper election officers the following title:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Arizona relating to public service corporations."

As to House Bill No. 103, Ch. 54, Laws of 1939, you should certify to the proper election officers the following title; giving each measure an appropriate number as directed in Section 1745, Revised Code of Arizona, 1928:

"An act relating to dentistry and amending Section 20, Chapter 24, Session Laws of 1935 Regular Session."
