Dear Sir:

I have before me your request for an opinion as to the constitutionality of House Bill 26, which provides for the exemption of interest on certain delinquent taxes if paid by a certain time.

We find that the Supreme Court of Arizona has ruled on this identical question in *Eiles v. Robey*, 30 P. (2d) 841. Based upon that case it is the opinion of this office that House Bill 26 is constitutional in all respects.
