Dear Sir:

I have before me your letter of June 24th requesting an opinion as to whether the appropriation to your department is governed by Section 67-805 (b), A. C. A. 1939, which provides that only 5% of all fees collected should be transferred to the general fund, or the provisions of the general appropriation bill of 1941 which provides that 10% of all fees shall be transferred to the general fund.

An examination of our files reveals that on May 10, 1938, an opinion was addressed to your department which completely answered this question. It is our opinion that this still is the law.
