Dear Sir:

We have your recent communication relative to the disposition to be made of the sum of \$300,000.00 received by you from the Federal Government for the first annual payment due June 1, 1938 under the provisions of the Boulder Canyon Project Adjustment Act. Attached to your letter is a copy of a letter from the governing body of Mohave County demanding that said county be credited with the greater portion of said sum.

We are advised that one of the State agencies is also making claim to this fund, therefore our opinion on the question you ask would not settle the controversy as to the disposition of these funds. We feel that the question of the disposition of the funds between the several claimants should be determined by the Courts, so we suggest that you refuse the demand of Mohave County so as to enable all the interested parties to go into Court for a final adjudication of the controversy.
