Dear Mr. Betts:

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of December 8, 1942, with enclosure of form of Articles of Incorporation designed to set up certain cooperative enterprises for evacuees under the War Relocation Authority.

With respect to your inquiry as to whether or not a foreign corporation formed on the pattern of such proposed articles can qualify in Arizona under Section 53-301, A.C.A. 1939, it is our opinion that the requirements of the section must be complied with before such corporation can do business in Arizona. In other words, we agree with your construction of the excepting portion of the statute, in that we consider it was not the legislative intent to except non-profit corporations from the application of the section.
