Referring to our telephone conversation of today in reference to the procedure to be followed in case the Superintendent of the State Prison has reason to believe a person in the prison under death sentence is insane, you are advised that in view of the recent decision of the Supreme Court in the case of State vs. Superior Court of Greenlee County, 131 Pac. (2d), 933, it is our opinion that proceedings in such cases should be had under the initiated act approved at the General Election of 1918.
