Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter of April 8 relative to the proposed construction of approximately 200 units of the dwelling type by a corporation for itself, the said units when erected to be for the sole purpose of renting to others.

Under such a state of facts we believe the person erecting the units would not be a contractor within the definition of that term as set forth in 67-803, A.C.A. 1939, for the reason that in erecting the units for itself it is not undertaking to erect same for a fixed sum, price, fee, percentage, or other compensation.
