Dear Mr. Abels:

We are in receipt of your request of this date asking our opinion as to whether H.B. No. 28 is constitutional.

We are of the opinion that if said bill is enacted by the legislature it would be constitutional.

While Section 2, Article 7 of the Constitution fixes the age for voting at twenty-one years or over, the bill in line 11, section one appears to take care of this question.
