Dear Mr. Shouse:

We have your letter of December 6, 1944, in which you ask if the Eskimo Cooler flavored ice bar conflicts with any regulation in the State Dairy Law.

Section 50-936, Frozen dairy products, in part reads as follows:

"* * * Ices, sherbets and other similar frozen products containing water as the principal ingredient thereof may contain a small amount of dairy products as stabilizer or to improve the texture thereof, in which case such product shall not be considered as a dairy product, providing that it shall not be labeled or sold as such or in imitation thereof."

It is our opinion that your enclosed envelop, "Eskimo Cooler", does not conflict with any regulation of the State Dairy Law.
