Dear Mr. Kitts:

In reply to your request of March 9, 1945, wherein you ask for opinion as to Senate Bill No. 30, which has been passed by the Seventeenth Session of the State Legislature and which has been signed by the Governor as of March 5, 1945, and replying directly to your question as follows:

"When it becomes official does it apply to youngsters who are committed to the Institution prior to its enactment."

It is our opinion that such law is effective, because of its emergency provisions, as of the date of signing by the Governor and further it is our opinion that section 2 of the act in amending section 46-136, entitled When Board May Release Child applies to all children theretofore committed to the Institution and would be effective not to part of the children in the control of the Institution but to all of them.
