Dear Mr. Timmerman:

We acknowledge receipt of your inquiry as to whether the provisions of Sec. 43-4807, A.C.A. 1939, prohibiting railroad employees from working in excess of sixteen hours without the nine hour period of rest in between, apply to inside engine hostlers and engine watchmen. We wish to advise you that we believe those persons are within the provision of the Statute.
