Dear Doctor Edmondson:

On your recent visit to this office you discussed with the writer the question of whether the Board of Directors of State Juvenile Institutions has the right to make "conditional releases of juvenile offenders who have been committed to their care".

This will confirm our advice to you at that time that in our opinion the Board may release a juvenile conditionally by placing him under the "care of any resident of the state who is the head of a family and of good moral character, on such conditions as the Board may impose." See Section 46-115, ACA 1939, as amended (Chapter 29, Laws of 1947).
