Dear Mr. Morris:

Re: American Buyers Casualty Company
Policy Form 170ABC

In accordance with the request in your letter of January 19 we have examined for legality the policy form referred to.

The close resemblance of the names "American Buyers Insurance Company" and "American Buyers Casualty Company" raises some doubt as to the propriety of the incorporation and certification of the latter company under Section 61-1003, ACA 1939.

However, since all formal requirements for incorporation have been fulfilled by American Buyers Casualty Company and a certificate having been issued thereto by the Corporation Commission, we must assume that the Commission is of the opinion that the two names are sufficiently different to allow such incorporation and certification of such company under the name it has adopted.

We are of the opinion that, under the assumption that American Buyers Casualty Company has rightfully adopted the name it uses, the policy form to which reference has been made is in conformity with law.
