RE: Mrs. Claude T. McIntyre

We have your letter of March 7 enclosing letter addressed to you from the Governor regarding the above recipient on your rolls together with statement signed by Richard G. Johnson.

It appears that Mr. and Mrs. McIntyre, pursuant to common practice, changed their ownership of a house and lot which was community property to ownership in joint tenancy with right of survivorship by means of a double exchange of deeds.

Reading Chapter 20, Seventh Special Session, 1948, in its entirety, we are of the opinion that such a transfer for purposes of converting community property ownership into joint tenancy does not render the recipient ineligible.
