In your letter of June 5, 1978, you requested an opinion from us regarding the question of your annual salary. We respectfully decline your opinion request.

The Attorney General's statutory duty to render written opinions is found in A.R.S. § 41-193.A.7. It provides that we shall:

7. Upon demand by the legislature or either house thereof, any public officer of the state or county attorney, render a written opinion upon any question of law relating to their offices. (Emphasis added)

The Mohave County Attorney is the appropriate party to answer the important question you posed.
