
Dear Governor Osborn:

I am writing you at the request of the Arizona Poultry Improvement Association concerning Mr. Tad Yoshizaki, an American-born Japanese, who for the past several years has been doing about all of the chick sexing for the Association.

It seems that the Association is having some difficulty in obtaining the services of Mr. Yoshizaki, due to the fact that his home is in Los Angeles, and the State of California will not permit him to leave the state without proper request. The Arizona Poultry Improvement Association has made this request to the Southern California Chick Sexing Association, Inc., 1903 Pennsylvania Avenue, Los Angeles, California, but they thought that to avoid any possible further trouble in his obtaining permission to enter Arizona you should be advised of the request.

Mr. Yoshizaki is an American-born Japanese and, so far as I am able to determine, has conducted himself in a very satisfactory manner. Each year there are about 3/4 of a million baby chicks sexed in the state and these Japs are the only people who are able to do the work satisfactorily. In case there should be any difficulty in obtaining a permit for Mr. Yoshizaki to enter Arizona, the Association will greatly appreciate whatever assistance you might give.
