Dear Governor Osborn:

I trust you will forgive my delay in responding to your letter of December 26, attaching copy of letter from Mr. Guy R. Walther of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. However, I have purposely left unanswered all correspondence dealing with our forced cut back of the veterans emergency housing program until I could be in a position to give concrete answers. We have spent three weeks in an intensive survey to determine which of the 18,554 units originally allocated to this Region could be completed with the extremely limited funds left for the program.

You are no doubt by now aware, and I am happy to be able to confirm it, of the fact that all units originally scheduled for the State of Arizona will be one hundred percent completed. This, of course, includes the 48 units at Winslow, the subject of your letter.

This will also acknowledge your telegram of December 28 on the same subject. Be assured I deeply appreciate your interest in the veterans' housing program and feel that in you housing has a sincere friend.
