Dear Harold:

This is sent in reply to your letter of recent date, wherein you request information regarding the disposal of surplus buildings at the former Prisoner of War Camp, Florence, Arizona. Plans for the proposed sale of surplus buildings at subject installation are at this time being formulated by the Los Angeles Office of the War Assets Administration. No definite date has been set at this time. We have made a record of your request and as soon as definite information is received, you will be informed.

As you are no doubt aware, this Agency purchases surplus buildings from the War Assets Administration and re-sells them to veterans as stipulated under provisions of Senate Bill #43. It is required that you, as a veteran purchaser, appear in person, present your honorable discharge or suitable certificate and make selection of the building that will be best suited for your particular needs. Generally the sales are conducted on a "First Come First Serve" basis.

I trust that the foregoing information is satisfactory for your purposes.
