

REPORT ON TUCSON/PIMA COUNTY CD SERVICES
as to willingness & preparedness
to operate in June 20th ALERT.

Council meeting held Monday evening May 25th.

"meeting of the minds of staff" versus "movement of the people" for June 20th ALERT.

Much discussion with most services favoring actual maneuvers, some asking that their service operate on paper this time.

Report by Services:

Fire- Will act in city area or any adjacent area that will permit them to still stay in contact with the city. (no area that is too far removed).
Rural Fire- offers to support city fire in a city or nearby county problem.

Utilities- water offers use of auxiliary engines (enough for essential purposes for limited time) in a city or county problem.

Medical- has full plan but can't use the feature of casualty stations in schools and recreational centers right now (proper contacts not fully made yet). Can evacuate hospitals. Medical & surgical teams are set up. Plan for obtaining supplies.

Communications- Will have Ham set up in control room at headquarters. Will inform public, and contact services in carrying our problem. Mobile unit for area work. Will coordinate telephones and communication units embodied in the services.

Police- will carry any traffic or law problems...call on highway auxiliary if necessary.

RADEF- will have to be a paper problem because not enough instruments available.

Air- Members of CAP as a Civil Defense unit and not a CAP unit will supply 10 aircraft for an active problem of flight. 10 planes would like to fly in either local problem or mutual aid problem.

Engineering- equipment catagoried and available...but do not wish to actually move it. Will check on availableness at time problem arises.

Legal- will be follow up problems.

Welfare- Prepared to handle what arises.

Health- Willing to be in problem. Mr. Blaeske, who is going to teach Biological Warfare, has asked for a problem.

Transportation- recently appointed and not prepared (out of city at time of the meeting) but will get actively to work soon as return to city.

E.O.D.- will be out of city on June 20th so can't handle problem.

Rescue- training not to start till truck arrives.
Participation?

Schools- not present.
