
Staff has determined the following:

71 Elector signatures have been collected	47 elector signatures were needed for 51%
53% (117/220) Homeowners signatures collected	51% needed of homeowners signatures
63% Assessed valuation (\$923,172/\$1,474,099)	51% needed of total value for area

Exhibit "A"

Annexation Legal Description

Starting at the intersection of Hereford Road and Hargess Ranch Road heading north on Hargess Ranch Road (T23S R22E S8). Annexation to include east of Hargess Ranch Road (Section 8), continuing north and including Section 5. Heading west on Ramsey Road, annexation includes T22S R22E S31 on the north side of Ramsey Road. Heading north on Calle Eldorado, proposed annexation to include area to east of Calle Eldorado (Section 30). District boundary intersecting Calle Eldorado as an extension of Double H Lane. Proposed annexation to include area north of Double H Lane, including T22S R22E Sections 13, 18, 19, 24. Continuing west on Double H Lane and then heading north on Ranch Road, annexation to include T22S R21E S1, S12.

The second area of annexation is located in the north Moson Road area. Beginning at the intersection of Moson Road and Highway 90, heading south on Moson, annexation to include area south of Horsethief Draw Road, on both the east and west sides of Moson Road. On the east side of Moson Road, annexation area continues south of Horsethief Draw Road until it reaches parallel to Winchester Road. On the west side of Moson Road, annexation includes area south of Horsethief Draw Road and continues to existing boundary of the Fry Fire District. Annexation area continues westward until reaching the Sierra Vista city boundary. Proposed annexation area is located at T22s R21E Sections 10, 11, 15, 21, 22.
