




There are four daily newspapers, as well as other smaller publications—our educational advantages are of the very best, there being three public grade school buildings, a fine high school building—ten different church organizations—three prosperous banks, and other banking and investment companies—ice works—light and water plants—a well equipped street railway service—two railroads, the M. & P. & S. R. V. R. R. connecting at Maricopa junction with the Southern Pacific railway Co's, line—the S. F. P. & P. Ry., running between Phoenix and Prescott and Prescott to Ash Fork—a new capitol building will be soon in process of construction, other business blocks recently completed and in course of erection testify to the rapid growth and future outlook of the city of Phoenix. As a basis of calculating the number of names making the present directory, it is safe to estimate a population of about 12,800, exclusive of Chinese and Indians, and including of course all outlying additions and suburbs which are not included in the corporation limits. 


