

EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 81-4

* IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY PROCEDURES *

WHEREAS, on June 16, 1980 a state of emergency was declared to exist in certain Arizona Counties because of an abundance of grasshoppers; and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$100,000 was allocated from the State of Arizona General Fund to be expended to meet the contingencies arising from this emergency; and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs for meeting this emergency have been determined and all claims for reimbursement paid;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State, do hereby terminate the declaration of a state of emergency of June 16, 1980 and direct that all unexpended funds pertinent to said declaration revert to the State's General Fund.
