EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 81-5

In accordance with established emergency procedures;

WHEREAS, on June 16, 1980 a state of emergency was declared to exist throughout the State because of a severe forest and grassland fire contingency; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of A.R.S. 35-192, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) was allocated from the State of Arizona General Fund to meet the threats arising from this hazard; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the claims for reimbursement to meet this emergency have been paid;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State do hereby terminate the declaration of a state of emergency of June 16, 1980, effective June 29, 1981. All unexpended funds pertinent to said declaration shall revert to the General Fund.


