

EXECUTIVE ORDER 92-28

ESTABLISHING A RETIREMENT ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE ARIZONA GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL RETIREMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, as Governor of the State of Arizona, I am committed to reducing the cost of government; and

WHEREAS, in order to serve the public interest and to reduce costs over time for the Arizona Game and Fish Department, an enhanced retirement program should be implemented.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Fife Symington, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority invested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of this state, hereby direct as follows:

1. A retirement incentive program be offered to all Arizona Game and Fish Department employees who are members of the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System.
2. The incentive to be in the form of three (3) years credited service for each employee that elects to retire under this program.
3. To benefit from this program, a member must retire between September 30, 1992 and October 30, 1992, inclusive.
4. That funding for this program shall be in accordance with Session Laws 1992, Chapter 341.
