

ESTABLISHING THE GOVERNOR'S FAMILY FRIENDLY  
ADVISORY TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, Arizona has a need of pursuing policies that are supportive and not destructive of the family; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide alternatives that assist employees in meeting the needs of their families and fulfilling their responsibilities at the work place; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to more effectively coordinate benefits, resources, and options at the work place for working parents and those caring for the elderly; and

WHEREAS, public and private employers have a need for work and family issue training and awareness at the work place throughout Arizona;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Fife Symington, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, hereby order and direct as follows:

That a Governor's Family Friendly Advisory Task Force be formed:

1. To work closely with public and private employers throughout Arizona and review family policies currently in existence.
2. To promote family friendly benefits, options and initiatives with employers and communities throughout Arizona.
3. To review new proposals and initiatives that support the family at the work place.
4. To assist employers in developing family friendly benefits and options at the work place.
5. To work closely with the Legislature, the Governor's Office, and all public and private organizations to actively support policies that sustain the health and well being of the working parent.
6. To prepare one semi-annual and one annual report on progress for submission to the Governor.


