

EXECUTIVE ORDER
No. 80 - 3
CREATING THE ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S
ECONOMIC PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT BOARD

GVI.3: E93/80-3

WHEREAS, it is desirable that growth and economic development within the fourteen counties in Arizona can occur in an orderly and planned manner; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative effort is necessary to channel effectively the efforts of the counties in planning economic development; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to establish an official institution to advise and cooperate with the Office of Economic Planning and Development in the accomplishment of these covenants;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and by the statutes of this state, do hereby create the Arizona Governor's Economic Planning and Development Board and order and direct:

1. The functions and purpose of the Board shall be:
 - a. Advise the Governor and Office of Economic Planning and Development on development policies, to encourage orderly planning and stimulate economic activity in this state.
 - b. Focus on the needs and economic development of nonmetropolitan communities within the state.
 - c. Recommend programs to aid communities in planning for growth.
 - d. Assist in developing policies to promote the diversification of the state's economic base.
 - e. Review policies to ensure the proper utilization of Arizona's energy and other natural resources.
 - f. Assist communities in developing and implementing their own objectives.
2. The Advisory Board shall be composed of at least fourteen and no more than twenty members. At least one member shall be a resident of each county of this state. The Chairman and the President of Arizona Association of Industrial Developers shall serve as ex-officio members of the Advisory Board.
3. The Advisory Board shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and the Board. A Chairman shall be selected annually.
4. The Board shall meet at the call of the Chairman and at such places within the state as he may designate. The Board shall meet no less than once each quarter.
5. The Office of Economic Planning and Development will provide such staff services for the Advisory Board as required to carry out the purposes and funding of this order.
6. This Order shall become effective immediately.
