

EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 83-2

GVL 311 14 28 83

DESIGNATION OF SERVICE DELIVERY AREAS UNDER THE  
JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

WHEREAS, subject to the requirements of the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982 (Public Law 97-300, Section 101), the Governor must designate sub-state service delivery areas (SDAs); and

WHEREAS, the Governor has received requests for SDA designation by local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Job Training Coordinating Council has formally submitted recommendations to the Governor for the establishment of SDAs; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has distributed to all interested parties a preliminary plan for designation of SDAs and adequate time was allowed for public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has received and reviewed all comments submitted by interested parties on the preliminary plan for SDA designation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Arizona by the Arizona Constitution and the Laws of Arizona, it is ordered that the following units of local governments in Arizona are designated as Service Delivery Areas for purposes of the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982:

City of Phoenix  
Balance of Maricopa County (excluding the City of Phoenix)  
Mohave, LaPaz, Yavapai, Coconino, Apache and Navajo Counties  
Yuma County  
Gila and Pinal Counties  
Indian Tribes  
Cochise County  
Santa Cruz County  
Graham County  
Greenlee County  
Pima County.
