

EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 86-2

REDESIGNATION OF SERVICE DELIVERY AREAS UNDER THE
JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

WHEREAS, subject to the requirements of the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982 (Public Law 97-300, Section 101), the Governor may redesignate sub-state Service Delivery Areas (SDAs); and

WHEREAS, the Governor has received a request and formal application for SDA redesignation of the Arizona portion of the Navajo Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Job Training Coordinating Council has formally submitted recommendations to the Governor for the establishment of this SDA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Arizona by the Arizona Constitution and the Laws of Arizona, order that the Arizona portion of the Navajo Nation be redesignated as a Service Delivery Area for purposes of the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982.
