

EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 86-3

RECEIPT OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION

MESA PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Mesa Public School District is a political subdivision of this State and has statutory authority under Section 15-502, Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), to employ teachers, principals and support personnel for the education of school-age children, it would be in the best interests of the District to inquire into the character and past criminal conduct of prospective employees of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety maintains a Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 for the purpose of procuring and maintaining information concerning arrests and convictions of persons for public offenses in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Identification Section is authorized pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 (B) (7) and (8) to provide criminal history record information to noncriminal justice agencies of political subdivisions of this State for the purpose of evaluating the fitness of prospective employees of such agency; and

WHEREAS, the Mesa Public School District is a noncriminal justice agency of a political subdivision of this State; and

WHEREAS, noncriminal justice agencies of political subdivisions of this State may receive criminal history record information from the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. Section 41-1750 (G) only by specific authority granted to that agency by statute, ordinance, or executive order, and subject to rules and regulations of the Arizona Department of Public Safety;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, under authority provided by A.R.S. Section 41-1750 (G), hereby authorize the Criminal Identification Section of the Arizona Department of Public Safety to provide and the Mesa Public School District to receive criminal history record information for the purpose of evaluating the fitness of prospective employees in accordance with those rules and regulations issued by the Arizona Department of Public Safety.
