

EXECUTIVE ORDER

RECEIPT OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION
ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
AND REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 84-2

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, has the delegated authority pursuant to Rule R2-5-201E, of the Department of Administration Personnel Rules and Interpretations, to conduct background investigations to evaluate the fitness of prospective employees; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, has statutory authority under Section 28-1303, Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S). to conduct investigations for the purpose of determining the fitness of prospective dealer and wrecker licensees; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety maintains a Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 for the purpose of procuring and maintaining information concerning arrests and convictions of persons for public offenses in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, The Criminal Identification Section is authorized pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 (B) (7) and (8) to provide criminal history record information to noncriminal justice licensing and regulatory agencies of the state for the purpose of evaluating the fitness of prospective employees and licensees; and


WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is a noncriminal justice licensing and regulatory agency of the state; and

WHEREAS, noncriminal justice agencies of the State may receive criminal history record information from the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 (G) only by specific authority granted to that agency by statute, ordinance or executive order, and subject to rules and regulations of the Arizona Department of Public Safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, under authority provided by A.R.S. Section 41-1750 (G), hereby authorize the Criminal Identification Section of the Arizona Department of Public Safety to provide, upon receipt of applicant fingerprint cards, and the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division to receive criminal history record information for the purpose of investigating prospective employees and dealer and wrecker licensees in accordance with those rules and regulations issued by the Arizona Department of Public Safety.

I further order and direct that Executive Order 84-2, pertaining to the same subject matter is hereby repealed.
