

EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 86-13

RECEIPT OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION  
PIMA COUNTY JUVENILE COURT

WHEREAS, the Pima County Juvenile Court has statutory authority under Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) Section 8-241 to award custody of dependent, delinquent or incorrigible children to reputable citizens of good moral character, and is responsible to determine moral character as an essential requisite in evaluating prospective custodians; and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Juvenile Court has statutory authority under A.R.S. Section 8-112 to conduct investigations of prospective adoptive parents not requiring certification pursuant to A.R.S. Section 8-105 (N), and is responsible to determine if they are fit and proper persons to adopt children; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety maintains a Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. Section 41-1750 for the purpose of procuring and maintaining information concerning arrests and convictions of persons for public offenses in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Juvenile Court in procuring this information for the purpose of awarding custody of juveniles not involved in the criminal justice process is considered a noncriminal justice agency of the state; and

WHEREAS, noncriminal justice agencies of the State may receive criminal history record information from the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Identification Section pursuant to A.R.S. Section 41-1750 (G) only by specific authority granted to that agency by statute, ordinance or executive order, and subject to rules and regulations of the Arizona Department of Public Safety;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bruce Babbitt, Governor of the State of Arizona, under authority provided by A.R.S. 41-1750 (G), do hereby authorize the Criminal Identification Section of the Arizona Department of Public Safety to provide, upon receipt of applicant fingerprint cards, and the Pima County Juvenile Court to receive criminal history record information for the purpose of evaluating the fitness of prospective adoptive parents and prospective custodians of juveniles in accordance with those rules and regulations issued by the Arizona Department of Public Safety.
