

EXECUTIVE ORDER
NO. 89- 19

WHEREAS, The City of Phoenix Municipal Court, has received an application from Michael Clifford, President, Victory Communications International, filed pursuant to A.R.S. Section 39-121.03(B), requesting a list of the names and addresses of persons arrested for driving while intoxicated from court records to be used for a commercial purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix Municipal Court, as custodian of said records, has determined that the furnishing of such reports for the commercial purpose stated therein would constitute a misuse or an abuse of public records; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix Municipal Court, has made application to me, Rose Mofford, Governor of the State of Arizona, pursuant to A.R.S. Section 39-121.03(C), requesting than I, by Executive Order, prohibit the furnishing of the public records sought for the commercial purpose stated;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rose Mofford, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby issue this Executive Order prohibiting the furnishing of the names and addresses of persons arrested for driving while intoxicated, from court records to Michael Clifford, President, Victory Communications International, for the commercial purposes stated in his application pursuant to A.R.S. Section 39-121.03(C).
