

EXECUTIVE ORDER

67-5

ESTABLISHING THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON  
THE STATUS OF WOMEN

The importance of utilizing to the fullest extent possible the wisdom, energy and judgment of women in meeting the increasing responsibilities of government has been demonstrated in a convincing manner in many areas. In pursuance of my desire to encourage women to make their full contribution as citizens, and to assist me in my responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Arizona, it is ordered as follows:

Part I - Establishment of the Governor's Commission on the Status of Women.

Section I. There is hereby established the Governor's Commission on the Status of Women.

Section II. The Commission shall be composed of not more than thirty-five (35) members appointed by the Governor from among persons with a competency in the area of public affairs and women's activities.

Section III. The Commission shall meet at the call of the Chairman.

Part II. Duties of the Commission:

Section I. The Commission shall study and review past efforts and progress and make recommendations for future action on:

- (a) Employment practices and policies, both public and private.
- (b) Services of whatsoever nature that may be performed by women, public and private, which would have a beneficial effect on the well-being of all our citizens and which would bring further recognition to the value of participation of women in such affairs.
- (c) Political, civil and property rights of all segments of society.

Section II. All executive departments and agencies of the Government of the State of Arizona are requested to cooperate with the Commission in the performance of its duties and studies.

Section III. The Commission shall submit a report of its recommendations and accomplishments to the Governor by November 31st of each year.
