ESTABLISHING THE ARIZONA
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY


PURSUANT TO the mandate of Subsection A of Section 10, Chapter 209 of the Laws of 1968, Fourth Special Session, as amended, (Article 41, Sections 1701, et seq.) and by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Arizona, it is formally proclaimed and directed by me that the Department of Public Safety shall become operative and effective on the date of July 1, 1969.

By this Executive Order, it is intended that all of the provisions of said act of the Legislature creating this Department shall be operative and in full force and effect.
