EXECUTIVE ORDER
73-1

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY IS ESTABLISHED

Pursuant to Chapter 142 of the Laws of 1972, Second Regular Session of the 30th Arizona Legislature (Senate Bill 1068), and by virtue of my authority as Chief Executive Officer of the State of Arizona;

I, JACK WILLIAMS, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby certify a plan for the assumption of the authority funds, functions and programs of the state agencies affected by the provisions of Chapter 142, and do declare that the Department of Economic Security is hereby established and operative.

The powers conferred upon the Department of Economic Security, the transfer and assumption of authority, all functions, programs, records, furnishings and property, equipment, all unexpended and unencumbered funds and personnel to the Department of Economic Security as provided in said plan, and all or any other changes contained in Chapter 142 shall become operative on the 15th day of January, 1973.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 97 of Chapter 142, and makes operative all the provisions set forth therein, and particularly those provisions set forth in Paragraphs A and D thereof, which read as follows:

A. The provisions of this act shall become effective at such time and to the extent that the governor by executive order declares that the department of economic security shall become operative and may be phased into effect, but in no event later than July 1, 1973, except as provided in subsection C.

D. Upon an executive order of the governor certifying a plan for assumption of the authority, funds, functions and programs of an agency affected by the provisions of this act, there shall be transferred the authority, functions, programs, records, furnishings and property, equipment, all unexpended and unencumbered funds and personnel to the department of economic security, according to such plan.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Arizona.
