EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 76 - 6

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 68-3 TITLED "CREATING THE ARIZONA STATE JUSTICE PLANNING AGENCY"

WHEREAS, Executive Order 68-3 of November 15, 1968 created the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency, and

WHEREAS, said Executive Order 68-3 vested authority in the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency to implement for the State of Arizona the provisions of "Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968" and the "Juvenile Delinquency Prevention and Control Act of 1968" enacted by the 90th Congress of the United States, and

WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 has been variously amended by the Congress of the United States, notably in the Crime Control Act of 1973 (Public Law 93-83) amending Title i on Law Enforcement Assistance, and

WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act is subject to further amendment in subsequent crime control acts of the Congress of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Delinquency Prevention and Control Act of 1968 likewise has been amended from time to time and supplanted by the "Juvenile Justice and Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974" and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice and Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 is also subject to further amendment by the Congress of the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Raul H. Castro, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and by the statutes of this state, do hereby order and direct:

1. Executive Order 68-3 is amended as hereinafter provided.
2. The Executive Director of the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency and this Office, to call upon any department, office, division or agency of the state and political subdivisions thereof, to supply such data, information or assistance as shall be necessary to the discharge of the responsibilities under Executive Order 68-3 as amended by this Order. Each department, office, division or agency of the state and political subdivisions thereof is hereby authorized and directed, to the extent not inconsistent with law, to provide such data, information or assistance to the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency.
3. The Agency shall, relative to the subject matter of Executive Order 68-3 as amended by this Order, have the power to promulgate all necessary rules, regulations and guidelines for the local law enforcement planning, for planning applications, and for the administration of the grants to local law enforcement agencies consistent with the Federal Acts cited above and such acts enacted or that may be enacted by the Arizona State Legislature pursuant to law enforcement and criminal justice planning for the State of Arizona.
4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
